##### *A. Improvement of Academic Achievement*

- Trimester 3 Learning – 5 full days couldn't have gone any better.
- Summer Social Emotional Learning – Social Workers created a summer SEL calendar to create activities to assist families over the summer, students can come in a day in June, a day in July and a day in August with their board for a treat
- Summer Reading Challenge – All Kids in EC through 4<sup>th</sup> grade were given summer reading books with a work sheet over the summer funded by ESSER monies. Students were given 5 books for the them to keep and read over the summer.
- JumpStart Programs for K, 1<sup>st</sup>, and 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade – 2week program for the incoming grades, to start students with routine building and get students familiar with the school and teachers will be for 2 hours per day 10 students in each group.

- Student Device Return and Drop Off – tech team coordinating student device and materials return and gave the students any items from teachers along with report cards.

- Greater Chicago Food Depository Summer Meals Program – for our 3<sup>rd</sup> year, working with Gourmet Gorilla on Mondays and Wednesday in coordination with New Hope Food Pantry. Open Kitchen will be providing lunches on Tuesday and Thursday.


